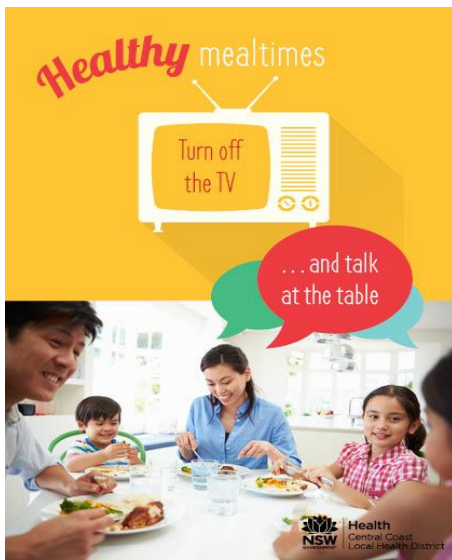
## LEARN TO SWIM
